The State Government has announced the launch of “Duare Sarkar” campaign vide this Department’s Memo No. 01-DS/P&S&PM/20 dated 26th November 2020, from 1st December 2020 to 31st January 2021, wherein outreach programmes / camps would be organised at Gram Panchayat and Municipal Ward levels for delivery of specified schemes of the State Government at the door-steps of the people.

Vide this Department’s Memo No. 01-DS/P&S&PM/20 dated 26th November 2020, further details regarding “Duare Sarkar” have been notified including the specific schemes that will be covered during the outreach camps. The Government has also notified that grievances and applications related to all Government Departments/Schemes would be accepted in these outreach camps. Further, details regarding the calendar/schedule of the outreach camps as well as the locations in which they will be held have also been given.

After due consideration, it is found that in order to ensure that “Duare Sarkar” is carried out smoothly and as per the manner envisaged by the State Government, and the overall objectives of the initiative are achieved, the local administration would require access to different types of support from all available sources.

Accordingly, it is ordered that resources and infrastructure including officials and staff, vehicles, laptop, furniture and buildings under the control of all government departments as per need should be made available on requisition by the Commissioner, Kolkata Municipal Corporation / District Magistrates for the purposes of “Duare Sarkar” initiative to ensure its success.

All Departments of the State Government will immediately issue appropriate enabling orders in this regard for compliance by their offices at headquarters and in the field.
