

**ORDER**

No. 89/RPT

WHEREAS, information has been received from credible sources that violent demonstrations are likely to take place resulting in large scale disturbances of the public tranquility and breach of the peace in the area as mentioned in the schedule below in the town of Kolkata (hereinafter referred to as the said areas) ;

AND

WHEREAS, I, **Vineet Kumar Goyal**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the **Notification No.2104- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021 read with the Notification No. 2102-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021 and the Notification No. 2105-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021 read with the Notification No. 2103-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021** to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974), am of the opinion, that there is sufficient ground for proceeding under the said Section for immediate prevention of disturbances of the public tranquillity and breach of the peace within the said area as mentioned in the following schedule in the town of Kolkata ;

Now, therefore, I, **Vineet Kumar Goyal**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata and Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974) read with the Sub-Section (3) of the said Section, do hereby prohibit for a period of **60 (sixty) days** from the **14.06.2022 to 12.08.2022** or until further order, **any unlawful assembly of five or more persons or taking out procession or carrying of lathi, any lethal or other dangerous weapons or doing of any act which is likely to cause disturbances of the public tranquillity and breach of the peace within the said area in the town of Kolkata.**

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed exparte under sub section 2 of section 144 of Cr.P.C. 1973. It shall be published for the information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the offices of All Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, all Police Stations concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation.

Any person contravening this order shall be prosecuted under the provisions of the extant applicable laws.

**SCHEDULE**

The area within the jurisdiction of Hare Street Police Station in the town of Kolkata bounded –

On the North by	-	Fairlie Place and India Exchange Place ( India Exchange Place and stretch of land from N.S Road - New Koylaghata Street crossing up to N.S. Road - Fairlie Place crossing being excluded ).
On the South by	-	Shaheed Khudiram Bose Road and Rani Rashmoni Avenue (the portion of Rani Rashmoni Avenue from its crossing with Chowringhee Road upto Govt. Place East being excluded).
On the East by	-	Brabourne Road, Dalhousie Square East, Old Court House Street & Govt. Place East (the road being included).
On the West by	-	Strand Road (the road being excluded).
Lalbazar Street	-	The Street and Footpaths on both sides included which extend from Dalhousie Square East to Rabindra Sarani (Lower Chitpur Road).

**EXPLANATION** : In this order, the TOWN of Kolkata means the town of Kolkata as defined in Section 3 of the Calcutta Police Act, 1866 (Bengal Act IV of 1866).
